- *pursuing ongoing improvement of environmental practices and pollution prevention;*
- *continuing to ensure respect of the relevant laws, regulations and standards, and periodically checking their prompt implementation;*
- *monitoring all possible pollution sources;*
- *ensuring proper operation of the waste water outlets, particularly those coming from the blending facilities, the chemical and microbiological laboratories and the plastics packaging washing area;*
- *implementing the necessary measures to avoid accidental releases into the atmosphere;*
- *applying management systems and procedures that comply with the UNI EN ISO 14001 standard, not only to prevent harm to health, safety, and the welfare of the community, but also to avoid any environmental damage to flora, fauna and more generally to the whole ecosystem;*
- *operating responsibly for the collection and disposal of waste;*
- *optimizing use of resources, energy and materials;*
- *reducing use of hazardous chemicals as much as possible;*
- *involving suppliers, particularly contractors, to ensure their behavior is environmentally sound;*
- *running preliminary environmental impact risk assessment before implementing new plant or a new process;*
- *coordinating Environmental Management System activities with those of the Quality Management System;*
- *involving the various levels of our organisational structure to ensure implementation of the company's strategic principles and improvement programs;*
